**Footnotes**

CONSCIENCE CLEAR moved up early to press front-running PLAY APPROVAL under light rating, moved to the fore nearing the final quarter, edged clear and was under intermittent urging the remainder. GRIFTER, well placed three or four wide from the outset, moved with the winner while outside that one entering the stretch but wasn't a match in the drive. TWO POINT TWO MILL, within easy striking distance, saved ground, angled five or six wide leaving the second turn but could gain only slightly in the late stages. ADVANCED EDITION, forwardly placed near the inside from the start, saved ground for three-quarters, cleanly avoided the spill and angled from between foes six wide into the stretch, was just off the top two for the last eighth but flattened out. NEWTOWN JET was outrun until the stretch, was checked lightly while outside the spill at the quarter-mile ground and improved position while unable to menace. SALOMON SWAGGER, unhurried early, moved five wide on the second turn, raced within easy striking distance into the stretch but was empty. NEWSPEAK, outrun until the stretch, was checked behind the rider of UNION MILLS when he was unseated, swung out 10 wide and wasn't a threat. PLAY APPROVAL bobbed lightly in his second or third stride, quickly recovered and maneuvered nicely to the inside while opening a clear lead on the first turn, made the pace until nearing the stretch, then tired. ON YOUR MARK, outrun while saving ground until nearing the stretch, was checked behind the fallen rider at the quarter-mile ground, angled out nine wide and was finished. UNION MILLS, well placed from the start, moved in behind rivals nearing the end of the backstretch, was advancing two or three wide entering the upper stretch when he appeared to clip the heels of PLAY APPROVAL, unseated the rider and crashed into several sections of the portable inner railing. Following a stewards' inquiry, no action was taken.
