Footnotes

SEFAPIANOS MISS moved up early to track front-running HOME PLACE three wide, continued in that position on the track and was hard ridden to be along in time. HOME PLACE gained the lead early, crossed nicely to the inside, made the pace into deep stretch and could not last. DAYLIGHT ROBBERY, well placed from the outset while four wide, loomed a strong threat for the final furlong and couldn't muster the needed response. CHERYL'S MYTH came out at the half-mile ground exchanging bumps with HOPEFOYOUANDI, raced inside until the final quarter, angled three or four wide but failed to muster a final response. HOPEFOYOUANDI leaned in bumping with CHERYL'S MYTH at the half-mile ground, raced inside and failed to rally. SOUTHERN STEPPER, outrun inside until the stretch, swung out seven wide for the drive and failed to menace while improving position. TURN TO SILVER followed the leaders in a striking position five wide into the stretch and flattened out. DAME BERTIE broke in the air, bobbed when landing, then wasn't a factor. KITTY CARNES never reached contention. ACUFF, five or six wide throughout, was outrun.
