Footnotes

FLYING MARLIN, unhurried early and four or five wide, moved in a bit on the far turn, swung out five abreast entering the upper stretch, caught CANYONETTE a sixteenth out and won going away under strong handling. CANYONETTE bobbed at the break, recovered rapidly to gain the lead, edged clear, made the pace into the final furlong and wasn't a match for FLYING MARLIN in the late going. MYTHICAL BROWNIE, well placed near the inside, flattened out the last eighth. BELMONT BLUES, unhurried early and five wide, moved to the rail on the far turn, reached contention in the upper stretch but lacked a late account. DANCE DANCE, in behind front-running CANYONETTE early, moved three wide between foes to force the pace on the backstretch, held on well until the stretch and faltered. I BELONG bumped the side of the gate at the start, quickly recovered, stalked the pace four wide until the stretch and tired. CALL ME MEG, in a striking position for six furlongs while following the leaders four or five wide, weakened thereafter.
