Footnotes

EXCLUSIVE HOPPER, rated near the inside from the outset, was never far back,moved between foes leaving the second turn, dropped to the inside, reached the front approaching the final furlong and was kept to her task. BLUE'S FIRST BABY pressed front-running ROYAL BELLA from early on, raced three or four wide, reached the front briefly in the upper stretch but couldn't contain EXCLUSIVE HOPPER in the drive. LA JOYERIA, well placed between foes three wide early, continued four wide around the far turn and into the stretch but couldn't muster a late response. MORGHYN settled near the inside early, inched closer on the far turn, fanned five wide into the stretch but had no rally. SCOTLAND PLACE, outrun to the stretch and four or five wide, angled a bit closer to the inside for the drive and improved position. CAPTIVE LADY raced within striking distance four or five wide until nearing the stretch and weakened. ROYAL BELLA gained the lead early, moved near the inside, made the pace for six furlongs and weakened thereafter.
