Footnotes

NIAGARA CAUSEWAY had his tack reset behind the starting gate. During the running, he tracked front-running MON SENOR from early on while lightly rated four wide, took over from that one in the upper stretch, drew clear and was under urging the remainder. LEAGUE OF NATIONS raced in behind horses three or four wide, inched closer leaving the second turn, was steadied leaving the furlong grounds when an opening closed five wide, angled closer to the inside in the late going and was all out to be up for the place. GAELIC STORM, always well placed and three or four wide, loomed prominently outside the winner for the final furlong and came up empty. MALAMEEZE tracked the pace four wide into mid-stretch and weakened. GLAMOUR GUY exchanged bumps with FAITH'S MAGIC at the start, moved inside, raced forwardly into the lane and flattened out late. MAJESTICO never reached serious contention. FAITH'S MAGIC leaned in at the start exchanging bumps with GLAMOUR GUY and was outrun. MON SENOR sprinted clear near the inside early, made the pace until the head of the stretch and faltered.
