**Footnotes**

VICTORY NOTION was unhurried into stride and tucked in at the tail of the field, responded when put to pressure with three furlongs to run, ranged up circling five wide, caught HOLY ANTHEM inside the furlong marker and was fully extended to wear that one down. HOLY ANTHEM tracked the pace four wide, drew even leaving the second turn, forged a narrow lead and battled gamely through the stretch but was turned away in the shadow of the wire. TORINI set the pressured pace three wide, then along the inside through the second turn, weakened during the drive but had enough left to hold the show. HYPE settled saving ground, was hemmed in through the second turn, swung to the outside entering the stretch but was left with too much to do. CAJUN PRIZE was allowed to settle, closed the gap from between horses, checked nearing the three-eighths marker, came again between rivals but failed to seriously threaten. PRESENTS FOR BERTI contended between horses, got through entering the stretch but lacked a response when called upon. CONSTABULARY chased the pace three wide to the stretch and faded. BEACH BEAU pressed the pace along the inside for six furlongs and stopped.
