Footnotes

MUSCADINE was allowed to settle, advanced four wide through the turn, drew even entering the stretch, wore down UNDER LIKE THUNDER and edged clear late. UNDER LIKE THUNDER settled off of the pace toward the inside, shifted out and forged command after a half, kept on well but was no match for the winner through the final furlong. HAZARDS OF LOVE settled in hand three deep, split rivals and angled in to make a mild bid but lacked the needed late response. MAGIC BULLET was allowed to settle between horses, came four wide to make a mild rally but failed to seriously threaten. CATCH TWENTY TWO settled saving ground, angled out entering the stretch but went evenly. JACK IN THE PULPIT was unhurried into stride, made a belated gain six wide but was never a factor. STORM MAKE'N opened clear to set the pace, was collared after a half and gave way readily once headed.
