WHO'S TALKING, outsprinted early and angled seven or eight wide at the five furlong pole, continued well off the inside, took over in the upper stretch, then was all out the remainder to hold SUBROGATE safe. The later, outrun inside early, saved ground into the stretch, worked his way out six wide for the drive and finished willingly. ROBAHUSH forced the pace from early on while four abreast, continued close up into the final furlong but lacked a late response. WOOSTERSHEAR gained a slight edge inside early, dueled into the stretch with several and weakened. LUDOVICUS, outrun early, saved ground, angled out seven or eight wide leaving the three-sixteenths pole but lacked a late bid. CATNIRO contested the pace from between foes three abreast until the stretch and weakened. SHEGARDI (GB) moved up early to vie for the lead near the inside between foes, gained a slim lead on the turn, then faltered in the drive.
