### Footnotes

LA REASON ducked out at the start bumping soundly with JAZZ TRADITION, went up soon after to press front-running ELLIS BASIN three or four wide, accelerated suddenly to wrest command just before going six furlongs, moved clear and was kept to her task. CAPTAIN'S DAUGHTER, rated three wide early, came out five or six wide for the drive and couldn't challenge the winner as second best. SWEET TRIP stalked the pace four or five wide, loomed prominently into the final furlong and came up empty. ELLIS BASIN gained the lead inside early, made the pace for nearly six furlongs and weakened. JAZZ TRADITION, bumped soundly at the start, angled inside, raced near the inside most of the way and failed to rally. THRONE raced four wide most of the way and was outrun.
