ITSALLBOUTTHECHASE within striking distance, moved up four wide on the turn, challenged approaching the stretch, drew clear with a furlong to go and stayed clear under steady urging. COWTOWN CAT never far back while off the inside, angled out for the drive, reached closest to the winner in upper stretch, could not gain on the winner in the final furlong but held on to be second best. SAVE BIG MONEY outrun to the stretch, improved his position to the furlong marker but lacked a further bid. STARSPANGLED GATOR close up from the start, moved up three wide before a half to challenge, battled to the final quarter and gave way. MR. TRIESTE vied for the lead off the inside and faded. CARNACKS CHOICE forced the pace along the inside and gave way the final quarter. I BELIEVE IN ME stumbled at the start unseating his rider.
