GALAXY MAKER vied for the lead off the inside, took over late on the turn, drew off into the stretch and was not menaced while kept to the task. SULLY'S LANDING steadied early when in tight, was outrun early, made a run three wide on the turn, angled out for the drive and rallied willingly for the place. IT'S A SIGNER reserved off the inside, improved his position while no threat. INFALLIBLE forwardly placed outside, challenged four wide on the turn but tired in the drive. VALUED ASSETS within striking distance off the inside, tired. CLEAR BOARD close up from the start, challenged three wide on the turn but faded in the stretch. BANDON DUNES forced the pace along the inside and gave way. ROMAN ALONG unprepared at the start, stumbled breaking, steadied when rushing to a forward position then stopped.
