Z ROCKSTAR vied for the lead off the inside, drew clear once in the stretch and held sway late. IT HAPPENED AGAIN within striking distance, raced off the rail on the turn, angled out for the drive and closed well on the outside. DYNAMICAL behind the leaders three wide, challenged the winner on the turn but weakened in the drive. SUNS OUT GUNS OUT reserved for a half, raced in traffic three wide late on the turn then finished willingly late when clear. STAY PUT outrun early four wide, came five wide into the stretch but lodged only a mild late bid. SIR BOND forwardly placed, saved ground on the turn and lacked a closing bid. RIDE THE LIGHTNING within striking distance four wide, tired. WHISKEY REBELLION alternated for the lead along the inside, held on well to the stretch and tired. ANOTHER GEAR five wide on the turn, faded.
