TAKE IT LIKE A MAN contended between horses, angled to the inside entering the stretch, was blocked and steadied near the furlong marker, shot through when PARKTOWN took a wayward stride outward and gamely edged clear. HIP FOUR SIXTYNINE was unhurried into stride, settled saving ground while well back, took closer order through the turn, slipped through along the rail entering the stretch, finished full of run but was unable to bridge the gap. COIN FLIP tracked three wide, loomed large entering the stretch, checked near the eighth pole when PARKTOWN floated out into his path, came again once clear but lacked the needed late response. PARKTOWN opened clear to dictate terms off of the inside, came out a lane a furlong out, was straightened away but weakened between horses late. TWIN ENGINE was allowed to settle, circled five wide and offered a mild bid entering the stretch but failed to sustain the drive. VELVET CAP settled saving ground, but lacked a response when called upon. PUSHTHEBUTTONMAX was forwardly placed between horses four wide for a half and faded. KING HENNY showed little in a dull effort. CANDY BITES made a middle move four wide but stopped entering the stretch.
