Footnotes

ECTON PARK, in hand while stalked the leaders three or four wide, moved from that position nearing the stretch to take over, was roused twice with the whip on the right side, then, after the rider changed to his left hand, three more times to increase his advantage late. HI GRADER saved ground from the start, raced close up, continued inside but wasn't a match for ECTON PARK while besting FLY FOREVER for second. FLY FOREVER leaned in and bumped ALISIOS at the start, gained the lead, raced in the three path, showed the way for six furlongs and weakened. SATANISTE, within easy striking distance from the start, raced four or five wide, loomed solidly for the drive but came up empty. HERE'S FIVE, bumped at the start and forced in, exchanged bumps with FLY FOREVER when that one came out, saved ground to the stretch, angled four wide for the drive but failed to respond. ALISIOS, bumped at the start, was steadied sharply in behind horses approaching the first turn, recovered to remain a factor for six furlongs and weakened. BALLROOM BLUR bore in on HERE'S FIVE at the start and was outrun.
