LAC ANNA vied for the lead while saving ground, took over leaving the backstretch, responded willingly when headed inside the final furlong and proved best late. RUNAWAY EMILY A, forwardly placed, off the inside, was angled out a bit for the drive, made a run at the winner inside the final furlong, gained a short lead in deep stretch but was outfinished. QUICK LAP, outrun early while saving ground, commenced her rally inside on the second turn, raced in traffic inside the final furlong, was angled out a bit and finished willingly late. JUSTENUFFHEART, reserved early inside, moved closer along the rail on the second turn, was in traffic inside the final furlong then lacked a solid late bid. ROZA ROBATA, unhurried early, advanced three wide into the second turn, steadied with three furlongs to go when behind rivals then lacked a solid late bid. MATHER MISS, outrun early while saving ground, was angled out in upper stretch but finished evenly late. I. C. CINDY, within striking distance early three wide, raced four wide on the second turn and tired. COUNTRY GARDEN (GB), never far back, made a run at the winner approaching the stretch, steadied when in tight inside the final furlong then faded. FLIGHT DELIGHT pressed the pace for five furlongs off the inside and faded.
