Footnotes

JUMP START moved up along the inside early to vie for the lead, gained a slight edge while dueling with WOLRD TRADE, was headed by that one nearing the five-sixteenths pole, was swept past by CASA CHICA in the upper stretch, then accelerated through the late stages under intermittent urging to win going away. CASA CHICA edged in early to track the dueling leaders four wide, moved to the fore leaving the turn, opened a clear advantage between calls but wasn't a match for JUMP START late. REQUEST FOR PAROLE worked his way inward early, raced within striking distance four or five wide, loomed a threat for the last eighth but came up empty. THREE STICKS, six wide much of the way, improved position but couldn't menace. BAY MONSTER leaned in at the break bumping MY MAN GUS, raced near the inside in a contending position until the stretch and lacked a closing bid. WORLD TRADE, away in good order to gain a slim lead, was headed from the inside by the winner before going a quarter, headed that one on the turn but faltered in the drive. RESTITUTION, outrun until the stretch, improved position but wasn't a threat. MY MAN GUS, bumped from both sides at the start, wasn't factor. EL HUICHOL, seven wide early, failed to contend. DEAD READY was never close nor was NATIVE MARK. PLAYING NOW drifted out at the start bumping MY MAN GUS, was checked soon after, raced in contention until nearing the stretch and faded.
