Footnotes

CAPTAIN CRYPTO settled in behind foes early, lacked room at the furlong grounds when steadied, was struck in the face about the sixteenth pole by the rider of MOON RULER'S whip, split foes three wide and was all out to be up in time. MOON RULER battled for the lead three wide outside of KENWIN, stuck a head in front at the eighth pole, then was outfinished. KENWIN gained a slight edge inside early, dueled with MOON RULER, was headed by that one and held on stubbornly. PUT UP OR, bumped at the break by OUR SEASON, was never far back and four or five wide, then lacked a final account. MANITOU, reserved early and angled inside, was steadied when rank on the backstretch, worked his way out five wide for the drive, managed a mild gain, then broke down and fell about 80 yards past the wire. CLASSICAL RHYTHM, well placed three wide, had no closing response. LUCKY TRAIN raced within easy striking distance near the inside into the stretch and came up empty. MYBELLEMAN forced the pace three abreast to the lane and tired. OUR SEASON ducked in bumping PUT UP OR at the start and was outrun. SIC EM PURD hopped while breaking slowly, then showed nothing.
