ATTRACTIVE RIDE opened clear to dictate terms, was well handled and gamely led throughout. BAUERS GOT HOURS settled in hand, ranged up four wide through the second turn, loomed large entering the stretch, was floated out a bid through the drive and was unable to reach the winner. MAX SILVERHAMMER was forwardly placed along the inside, got through to make his bid and was making up ground. SUN BEAR was close up three wide, but weakened between horses entering the stretch and gave way. AVENSTOKE was allowed to settle toward the hedge, angled out entering the stretch but failed to improve position. CARNIVAL RIDE broke a step slow, was unhurried into stride and was never a factor.
