DANGER STORM was away in good order to set the pressured pace, opened clear after a half, increased the lead entering the stretch, was kept to task and held safely. CASEY'S IMAGE settled in hand, circled five wide to make his bid, failed to menace the winner but kept on well to prove the best of the rest. NUMEN LUMEN settled saving ground, got through and finished well to earn the show. CALDO CAT was unhurried into stride, settled well back, circled six wide and finished with a belated gain. ADARO shifted out leaving the chute, prompted the pace between horses to the stretch and tired. MICHAELS PARK was hustled along between horses, came four wide but lacked a response when put to pressure. GLOBO DE ORO was allowed to settle four wide and was never a factor. SOUPED UP FAST was close up four wide to the stretch and retreated. LUCKIE CHUCKIE saved ground to no avail.
