Footnotes

CHUMSIE, in hand early while saving ground, came around a tiring BLUE DIAMOND RUN entering the stretch, returned to the rail when straightened for the drive and drew clear under strong handling. ADDED TIME, within striking distance while racing near the inside for a half, angled between foes five wide in the upper stretch, couldn't menace CHUMSIE but earned the place. NAUGHTY MAMBO, well placed while following the leaders four or five wide, attempted to drift out slightly at the five-sixteenths, loomed a solid threat for the final furlong but failed to respond. BELOVED BY ALL pressed the pace from early on, gained the edge on the turn but weakened in the drive. SHIRLEY TEMPER settled near the inside early, reached easy striking distance upon going a half, came out to rally from between horses five wide but flattened out the last eighth. DRESSED IN GOLD, forwardly placed while near the inside for a half, came out three wide to advance between foes entering the stretch but tired when straightened for the drive. LOVEABLE MANDY, six or seven wide most of the way, failed to menace. BLUE DIAMOND RUN made the pace inside for nearly a half and gave way.
