Footnotes

SACRED FEATHER sprinted clear early, raced three wide, came out a bit farther on the track entering the upper stretch, was sharply roused, then continued under strong handling to widen a bit at the end. SKITTER, never far back while in behind horses, raced four wide into the stretch, angled inside the winner late and was fully extended to be up for the place. WIND SURF, outsprinted early, edged up between foes on the turn, angled five wide into the lane, loomed a solid threat but lacked a late response. FOREVER BERTIE tracked the pace four wide into the final furlong and flattened out. PINING drifted out at the start, raced six wide early, then tired nearing the stretch. SHOW CAREER chased the winner four wide until the stretch and tired. SWAVOMIRA, forwardly placed to the turn five wide, weakened thereafter.
