POSSIBLE settled inside early, raced two wide on the turn, worked his way out five or six wide for the drive and was fully extended to wear down NEWPORT HARBOUR in the late going. NEWPORT HARBOUR tracked the pace four wide, leaned in tightening it up on AIDAN at the three-sixteenths pole, gained a slim lead, drifted in slightly in the final sixteenth and could not last. MIMS EPPLI, outrun to the stretch four wide, altered course seven wide very late from behind a wall of horses to secure room and finished well. AIDAN, up close inside early, moved between foes on the turn, continued between rivals into the lane, was steadied the first time at the three-sixteenths pole when NEWPORT HARBOUR leaned in, dug in, then was steadied again in the late going when NEWPORT HARBOUR leaned in and ITS READY came out slightly. ITS READY sprinted clear two wide, made the pace into the upper stretch, faltered and drifted out slightly about the sixteenth pole. SEVENDAYSMAKEAWEEEK settled two or three wide, came out seven wide for the drive but was empty. SPIRIT LINE broke in the air, bobbed when landing and never was a factor. OUR CLEVER SECRET, unruly in the post parade, was outrun. FOLLOWING A STEWARDS' INQUIRY, NEWPORT HARBOUR WAS DISQUALIFIED FROM SECOND AND PLACED FOURTH FOR INTERFERENCE IN THE STRETCH.
