### Footnotes

WESTSHORE bumped with THOMAS J at the start, sprinted clear and angled to the rail, set the pace inside, responded when headed before a half, battled BROKEN TANGO to the quarter mile marker, responded when asked to pick up his pace and drew off under steady handling. MINE TRAIN reserved early three wide, made a run in that path down the backstretch, challenged approaching the stretch but tired in the drive. THOMAS J bumped at the start, raced behind the leaders near the rail, angled out for the drive but tired. BROKEN TANGO bumped at the start, recovered to be close up while off the rail, gained a short lead outside the winner before a half, raced with that one to the final quarter and gave way. STORM FALCON reserved early near the rail, was no threat. BOLD VICTORY within striking distance, raced three wide on the second turn and faded.
