SOME KINDA TROUBLE settled saving ground, closed the gap through the second turn, got through entering the stretch and quickly drew clear. STEVE'S REVENGE set the pressured pace off of the inside, was unable to match strides with the winner but stayed on well to hold the place. CARACAS settled in hand, ranged up five wide to make a mild bid but lacked the needed late response. SQUANDER was close up along the inside, but weakened during the drive and gave way. GOOD QUESTION was hustled along four wide, advanced between horses to make a mild bid but failed to sustain the drive. BRAVO WHISKEY was unhurried into stride, finished with a belated gain but failed to threaten. SHORE BREEZE ICON was hustled along four wide and went evenly. GEOCACHE pressed the pace four wide through the second turn and faded. JOLLY OL' NICK showed little. BUDDHA CAN DANCE was forwardly placed for six furlongs and dropped out. CANADIAN WISH settled in hand, was caught in tight between horses, steadied near the seven-sixteenths pole and showed little thereafter. GIFT COUPON was through early.
