AMERICAN LEGEND lunged at the start, rushed up between horses, shook clear entering the stretch and held sway. PISGAH STATION broke slow, advanced between horses, angled out six wide, kept on well but was unable to reach the winner. DO YOU LIKE MONEY was allowed to settle, moved into

striking position between horses, got through entering the stretch but lacked the needed late response. CACTUS COGNAC contended between horses, offered a mild bid entering the stretch but failed to sustain the drive. DISTINCTIVE HEART pulled to the lead along the inside, disputed the issue to the stretch and gave way. MUCHO MACHO UNO raced wide throughout, finished with a mild gain but failed to threaten. GALLANT GREY was close up four wide through the turn and tired. SHOT AN A GOAL was unhurried, finished with a belated gain six wide. ZARKING vied for the lead between horses but came up empty leaving the turn and retreated. THIRSTY THURSDAY showed little. LOGGED was outrun. MARCHING ORDERS was forwardly placed along the inside for a half and dropped out.
