GOLD ELEMENT settled in hand three deep, tipped out five wide entering the stretch to launch his bid, wore down the leader inside the furlong marker and kicked clear. WHY PRETEND was allowed to settle, circled six wide to make a late rally and finished well to garner the place. AMMAROO was close up four wide, kept on through a prolonged drive and earned the show through a dogged effort. ISTHMUS opened clear to set the pace along the inside, was headed leaving the turn, shifted out entering the stretch but went evenly through the drive. PHILIPPE contended off of the inside to the stretch, but faltered between horses and faded. GALIENTOS stalked the pace two wide, took over before going a half, opened clear and angled in entering the stretch, but came up empty in the final furlong and retreated. MOTOR CITY was unhurried into stride along the inside, settled well back, got through to make his bid, was caught in tight in the final sixteenth, steadied and was not urged thereafter. OUR DARK KNIGHT broke slow and was never a factor.
