**Footnotes**

STRASBOURG disputed the pace three wide, edged clear leaving the turn, turned back the bid of BOB CAN'T JUMP and held sway under steady urging. BOB CAN'T JUMP tracked the pace three wide, bid between horses, bumped with DUNRAVEN PASS entering the stretch, kept on well and moved up to engage the winner with a furlong to run, but was unable to match strides late. DUNRAVEN PASS broke a step slow, moved up five wide to make a mild bid, bumped with BOB CAN'T JUMP near the three-sixteenths pole, flattened during the drive but had enough left to hold the show. TOWNER was fractious in the gate, broke slow, ranged into contention willingly, wheeled out six wide leaving the turn, but came up empty in the drive and failed to seriously threaten. FIRETACK vied the lead along the inside, contested the issue to the stretch and faded. CROWNE ROOM was forwardly place early, settled off of the pace on the turn and was never a factor thereafter.
