Footnotes

HALON broke sharp, settled off of the pace in hand four wide, took over entering the stretch, shook clear and widened at will. VASTEN was allowed to settle, ranged into position five wide through the turn, loomed a danger entering the stretch but was no match for the winner through the drive. HIGHLANDBRO tracked three wide, bid between horses entering the stretch but lacked the needed late response. STRIKE ONE hesitated at the start to get away behind his field, was unhurried into stride, angled out six wide and improved position through the lane. BOX OFFICE was unhurried off of the inside, swung eight wide leaving the turn and finished with a belated gain. CAPTAIN DAVRICK was jostled between horses at the start, recovered quickly and contended between horses, but weakened entering the stretch and faded. BLUEGRASS SHOES contested the pace between horses to the stretch and tired. MEOWSER was slow into stride, finished with a belated gain between horses but failed to threaten. MYKINDAGOLD failed to respond. E. M. MAXIMUS broke slow, settled saving ground, angled out entering the stretch but lacked a response when called upon. AN SHANACHIE disputed the pace four wide to the stretch and stopped. HEATED showed brief speed off of the inside but was through before going a half.
