Footnotes

TUTORIAL, unhurried into the backstretch, was taken five wide, edged closer on the second turn, made a sweeping run five abreast approaching the stretch, took over and edged clear late under strong handling. MY SWEET CAROLINE went up early to press pacesetter FLASHY CAT four wide, gained a slim lead on the second turn, then couldn't handle TUTORIAL in the drive. FAST DELIVERY, rated in behind the leaders early, raced three or four wide into the stretch, came out a bit farther for the drive and couldn't muster a serious response while improving position. SILVER CHELE, well placed from early on while stalking the leaders three or four wide, was empty when the test came. FLASHY CAT gained the lead early, raced three wide, made the pace for nearly six furlongs, lost the advantage to MY SWEET CAROLINE and weakened gradually the last eighth. NAUGHTY CROWN edged inside early, saved ground, advanced with the winner while inside that one approaching the stretch but was empty in the drive. ROCKTHEBOAT, in hand while saving ground from the beginning, faded in the drive. ENCOURAGER'S GUILT raced six wide much of the way and wasn't a factor.
