Footnotes

HALORY LEIGH, never far back while tracking the leaders five wide, moved to the fore in the upper stretch, then won going away under energetic handling. SULTRY SAL battled for the lead from early on while three abreast, gained a slim lead on the turn but was no match for the winner in the drive. RED CELL, well placed near the inside between foes, moved five wide into the stretch, improved position but couldn't threaten the winner. CHIRIMOYA settled between foes three or four wide, made a bid five wide into the final furlong but flattened out soon after. WOOF dueled for the lead early while between foes, raced close up to the stretch and tired. PERKY PEAKS, outrun three or four wide to the stretch, circled foes 10 wide and improved position while unable to menace. PADMORE ducked out at the start bumping DEL RAE, raced in contention five wide to the stretch and was empty in the drive. SUGAR CANDY tired while near the inside throughout. DEL RAE, bumped at the start and checked, was angled inside soon after and failed to menace. KEY APPROVAL gained a slim lead inside early, dueled with WOOF and SULTRY SAL for a half and tired.
