Footnotes

SILVER WENCH hustled to the fore inside early, dueled with GLITTER TIME, kicked clear into the upper stretch and widened when kept to her task while drifting out late. RARE GOLD, well placed inside to the stretch, eased out three or four wide for the drive and was second best. SHIBUI bobbed sharply at the start, was outrun to the stretch, angled six wide for the drive and improved position. SHELLSEEKER tracked the pace four or five wide into the final furlong and flattened out. SMART LOVIN', three or four wide, came a bit wider for the drive and was empty late. GLITTER TIME broke through the gate prior to the start and was alertly grabbed by the assistant starter. Upon being reloaded, GLITTER TIME vied for the lead at once while outside the winner, raced forwardly to the stretch and tired. REVOLUTIONARY ACT, reluctant to load into the gate, raced close up early, drifted out six or seven wide on the turn and tired. FLIGHT OF TIME was finished after three furlongs.
