NEED MONEY DAD went up early to press front-running HOOSIER AMBASSADOR four wide and continued in that manner to wear that one down in the closing yards. HOOSIER AMBASSADOR gained the edge early, raced in the three path, made the balance of the pace but could not turn back the winner at the end. BOOTCO, steadied behind the top two early, was steadied again at the five-sixteenths pole, continued near the inside when rallying into the lane but could not offer the needed response. BILLY BOB CAT, five wide, lacked a closing bid. BRAZENLY BOLD, outrun to the lane and five wide most of the way, lacked a closing account. ITSTRUEDANCING drifted out while bobbling and bumped B. B. MANCINI, raced in contention four wide to the stretch and weakened. B. B. MANCINI, bumped at the start and steadied, never menaced. LOW RIDER, sluggish to start, raced near the inside and never was a factor. A FOUL CLAIM LODGED BY THE RIDER OF BOOTCO AGAINST THE WINNER FOR ALLEGED INTERFERENCE ON THE BACKSTRETCH WAS DISALLOWED.
