Footnotes

HYRACOTHERIUM within striking distance off the rail, advanced three wide on the second turn and wore down the leader late. HOLD THE SALT sprinted clear, set the pace along the inside but failed to last. HIGHEST DEGREE reserved along the inside, angled out three wide late on the second turn but lacked the needed closing bid. EL INDY in tight approaching the first turn, between rivals, was unhurried off the rail, angled out for the drive and finished willingly. GOLDEN GLEN outrun along the inside, angled out for the drive and made a late gain. SNAKE RIVER CANYON close up along the inside, tired in the drive. RED ALERT forwardly placed off the inside, gave way. GRAND (IRE) was outrun.
