SARATOGA SINNER disputed the pace three deep, shook clear entering the stretch and widened through the drive. ZION attended the pace off of the inside, came four wide to make his bid, failed to menace the winner but finished willingly to clearly prove the best of the rest. GREAT CRUSADE was allowed to settle, made a late rally circling four wide and was along for the show. DON'T PUT IT BACK was rank to place, pulled to the lead four wide, but faltered entering the stretch and faded. POINTING HOME contested the pace between horses through the turn and gave way. NORTHERN PRINCE showed little in a dull effort. JEDI CODE rushed to the lead along the inside, but came up empty after six furlongs and dropped out.
