FAIRVIEW vied for the lead three wide, took over when ready entering the stretch then held sway late under pressure. GILDED WORDS, outrun early off the inside, moved through traffic in midstretch then rallied willingly late. VALID CLEARANCE, forwardly placed off the inside, moved three wide between rivals entering the stretch then finished well late along the rail. DUEL AUTHORITY forced the pace from the start, raced in the four path on the turn and weakened in the final furlong. COUNTACH, within striking distance while reserved, had no response in the stretch. FATIMA BLUSH pressed the pace between rivals, stayed well to the stretch and tired. LA PARMA alternated for the lead along the inside, held well to the quarter mile marker and tired.
