SLIVER OF SILVER set the pace off the inside and slowly drew clear under steady urging. PREMIER PEAK pressed the pace, raced in the three path on the turn and held on gamely in the drive to be second best. MEGANS BLUFF, forwardly placed, raced three wide on the turn and tired in the final furlong. FAITHFUL HEART, within striking distance, was in the four path on the turn and gave way in the stretch. SECRETSINTHESKY, angled in nearing the turn when midway back in the field, raced just off the rail on the turn, came off the inside with a quarter mile to go but tired in the stretch. TAKE ME IN, outrun early, raced along the inside on the turn and was no factor. CALL YOUR BEAU, within striking distance three wide, faded. DADDY'S DARLIN', rank after the start, was outrun. MISS BARBARA was outrun three wide. CLASS was far back. HOWABOUTME, forwardly placed off the inside, stopped. I LOVE JAZZ was no factor.
