Footnotes

FAVORITE GIRL, rated in behind the dueling leaders early, split horses three wide at the eighth pole and drove clear. HONOURABLE ASSET, in front after the start, contested the pace between foes, battled close up into the final furlong and wasn't able to match strides with the winner late. DEPUTYMAYORMARGRET, never far back, made a bold run five wide into the lane, stuck a head in front at the eighth pole but failed to sustain the needed momentum. SWISS VALLEY settled inside early, made a solid run five wide into the final furlong but lacked a further account. GLISTEN, in contention four or five wide throughout, failed to rally. SECOND PRES hopped at the start, moved inside, saved ground to the stretch, came out nine wide for the drive and wasn't a threat while improving position. LILA KAY'S ROSE edged in early, forced the pace three abreast for five furlongs and tired. NATIVE FEVER, four or five wide, wasn't a factor. MISS MAGNOLIA moved to a narrow advantage inside early, dueled for a half with HONOURABLE ASSET and LILA KAY'S ROSE and weakened thereafter. LAVENDER SEA raced five wide and faded early.
