JOHN KELLY stalked the pace two wide, took over leaving the turn, shook clear and maintained a safe advantage. CAPT OBVIOUS was allowed to settle, circled four wide and was getting to the winner late. BAKU BREEZE angled in to save ground, swung to the outside entering the stretch and finished willingly to earn the show. WAR BALLAD was forwardly placed three wide, loomed a danger entering the stretch but went evenly through the drive. COACH BILLY G. broke slowly, rushed to contention five wide, but weakened during the drive and faded. MAGNIFICENT MAX (GB) attended the pace along the inside to the final furlong and gave way. BEGRIFF was away alertly to set the pace, was collared leaving the turn and gave way readily once headed. SANDECKER passed only his tiring rivals. OPTION saved ground to no avail. PIANO RED showed little. HERITAGE HALL was outrun. JUSTIN was through early.
