Footnotes

CHECKSANDBALANCES attended the pace three deep between horses, poked his head in front with a furlong to run, and was fully extended to prevail under stern urging. PRIZE MASTER vied for the lead along the inside, battled through a prolonged drive but was denied in the final stride. KSAR GHILANE made a long drive circling five wide, loomed large entering the stretch but lacked the needed late response. STORM SIGHT was unhurried into stride, angled out to make a mild rally but failed to seriously threaten. ESSENCE OF SPEED broke a step slow, rushed up to dispute the pace from between horses, but came up empty entering the stretch and faded. SON OF A CHIEF stumbled badly at the start and was away well behind his field, rushed to contention along the inside but had little left for the drive. ALL STAR CHRIS contended four wide, drew even from between horses with a quarter to run, but faltered in the final furlong and dropped out.
