KNIGHT SHOT vied for the early lead along the inside, dropped back a bit into the turn and angled out, came three wide into the stretch, gained a short lead with a furlong to go and drew clear. WHY STILLY WHY alternated for the lead off the rail, took over entering the turn, led the field into midstretch, could not stay with the winner late but held on to be second bests. BADGER BRET within striking distance, advanced three wide on the turn but lacked a late bid. BELLEOFTHEVALLEY behind the leaders the wide, tired in the drive. ROYAL PRIDE within reach of the lead off the inside, gave way. PAINTED KITTEN forwardly placed, saved ground on the turn and tired in the drive. NAICHE was no threat along the inside. MISS CHLOE'S BOY three wide on the turn when back in the field, could not threaten. PAYING THE BILL was outrun. DRAW THE TAP was no factor.
