Footnotes

FLATTER went up early to duel for the lead five wide in hand, battled with VIRTUAL ZONE, took over three furlongs out, shook off a mild challenge from BIG TALKING MAN entering the stretch and won going away under mild hand urging. U. S. JETS, outrun for a half and three wide, came out six wide for the drive and bested the others while no threat to FLATTER. VIRTUAL ZONE gained a slight lead early, raced three wide while dueling with the winner, lost the advantage to that one three furlongs out and weakened. BIG TALKIN MAN, never far back while three wide, made a run at FLATTER five wide at the quarter-mile ground but faltered when straightened for the drive. DISCREET HERO, well placed near the inside from early on, angled between rivals in the upper stretch, moved out five wide at the furlong grounds but flattened out. MISSME, near the inside throughout, was through leaving the turn. GOLD DOLLAR, six wide on the backstretch, edged in around the turn, came out again to race seven wide in the stretch and never menaced.
