### Footnotes

STORM DAY, never far back and saving ground until the stretch, angled six wide for the drive and was hard ridden to prevail. BIDIS, off a step slow, reached contention inside early, made a bold run from the rail nearing the final furlong and was outfinished. DREAM TRIPPER went up early to press pacesetting EGGBERT three or four wide, gained a slim lead in the upper stretch but weakened late. WHATIS IS stalked the leaders three or four wide, gained near even terms for the front at the furlong grounds but weakened. EGGBERT gained the lead early, raced three wide, made the pace until the stretch and weakened. SLIP ME A MICKEY failed to menace in an even effort. CARELESS FEELINGS, eight wide during the early going, edged in around the turn but wasn't a factor. TIGER WON was outrun.
