**Footnotes**

GOODAS I. LOOK moved inside early, raced in hand, angled between foes four wide on the second turn to advance, reached the front nearing the final sixteenth and was hard ridden the remainder. BROWN EYED LASS angled inside early, saved ground while edging up on the second turn, angled four wide from between foes for the drive, loomed menacingly for the last eighth but couldn't match strides with the winner. LAPUMA, eased back and to the inside early, was unhurried for a half, swung out six or seven wide for the final quarter, loomed a solid threat but couldn't muster the needed response. BOGGS EYES worked her way inward early to gain the lead, raced two or three wide while dueling with CHARM, alternated for the advantage into the final furlong and weakened. CHARM, bumped at the start, was never far back, moved up outside BOGGS EYES on the first turn, raced four or five wide, battled for the lead with BOGGS EYES, continued close up into the final furlong and weakened. SISTER CRIMSON leaned in at the start bumping CHARM, stalked the dueling leaders three or four wide until the stretch and weakened. ZAMBA CANUTA, five or six wide throughout, failed to rally. DISCO LADY, forwardly placed along the inside for a half, faded gradually on the second turn. ANGRY NURSE, within striking distance while racing near the inside between foes, made a run four wide on the second turn but was finished when straightened for the drive.
