Footnotes

NATURALLY WILD moved up early to press front-running WORD PUZZLE, raced three or four wide, advanced after that one approaching the stretch, took over, edged clear, then was kept to strong handling. DIAMOND BRACELET, checked in behind WORD PUZZLE approaching the first turn, saved ground for nearly six furlongs, came out four wide for the drive and couldn't menace the winner while fully extended. TRUE RUBY, unhurried early and five wide for six furlongs, came out seven or eight wide for the drive and offered a mild gain. K. C.'S GIFT, well placed from early on, raced four wide, angled six wide to make a run into the final furlong but lacked a serious response while improving position. ALIDA, outrun to the far turn and three or four wide, came out six abreast when straightened into the stretch and improved position while unable to menace. GOODAS I. LOOK, near the inside within easy striking distance, angled between rivals five wide to make a run into the final furlong but flattened out late. TEMIS (CHI), reserved early and maneuvered near the inside early, moved four wide on the backstretch, came out nine wide for the drive but never threatened. WORD PUZZLE gained the lead early, moved near the inside, made the pace for almost six furlongs and tired. BALDWINA (FR), well placed in behind the leaders three or four wide into the stretch, flattened out when straightened for the drive.
