STONESTREET LADY vied for the lead off the inside, repulsed several bids late on the turn and drew off under steady urging. JANE'S BABY within striking distance off the inside, lodged a mild bid to be up for the place. WILLOW CREEK outrun early, raced in the four path on the turn and made a late gain. CHIT CHAT CAT with the early pace between rivals steadied near the nine sixteenths pole, recovered, made a run to challenge late on the turn but tired in the drive. CRAZY THING forced the pace from the inside, stayed on well to the stretch and gave way. ROCKIN ROSE reserved along the inside, was no threat. YOUTHQUAKE outrun off the inside, was no factor. EASY ASHLEY prominent three wide, faded. AMBER ROOM could not menace three wide.
