RACING WILDLY opened clear to set the pace three wide and was fully extended to just last. VICTORIA'S VISION settled in hand four wide, tucked in on the turn, got through along the rail entering the stretch, shifted out for the final sixteenth, split horses and was gaining with every stride. LITTLE FRILLY broke slow, settled saving ground, closed the gap along the inside through the turn, got through entering the stretch but flattened during the drive and settled for the show. QUIXOTE'S LADY was close up three wide, shifted to the outside of RACING WILDLY after the opening quarter, came four wide but faltered between rivals and faded. ARE WE THERE YET was forwardly placed off of the inside through the turn and wilted. BLUE CLIFF stumbled at the start, moved up six wide to make a mild bid but failed to sustain the drive. PRETTY LIL' KATE contended five wide for a half and dropped out.
