FIVE DELIGHTS went up soon after the start to force the pace three abreast while in hand, took over just before going a half, drew clear in the upper stretch and was ridden out the remainder. SALTY COUNTESSA, well placed behind the dueling leaders from early on, angled out and split foes four wide, was just off the winner for the last eighth but couldn't muster a challenge. CHEROKEE PAINT followed the leaders four or five wide throughout, raced within easy striking distance and failed to rally. TEMPO DI BOLERO gained a slight edge early while dueling between foes, surrendered the advantage to winner just before going a half and weakened. AUDREY'S ANGEL, within striking distance and saving ground into the stretch, was empty when the test came. KOSSANOVA vied for the lead inside the opening half and tired. RIVERMAN'S TEA, off slowly, was outrun early, reached contention upon going a half and lacked a further account. DEBT FREE passed tired ones. JOVE'S AUBEE failed to menace. LUCKY CHEROKEE was done early. AFFAIR DAY was outrun. COLONIAL GOLD was through early.
