Footnotes

RED DICE gained the lead early, raced three wide, came five wide while settling into the stretch with a clear advantage and was hard ridden to the wire. GREETING CARD drifted out at start bumping SQUAW SPIRIT, raced in a striking position four or five wide to the lane, angled inside the winner for the last eighth and offered a mild gain. CARINA, six or seven wide early, raced five wide into the stretch and was slowly gaining late. ANGIE'S CAT tracked the pace four or five wide, moved inside the winner for the final furlong but came up empty. DEFAMATION moved inside concluding the backstretch while outrun, came out six wide for the drive and improved position while unable to menace. SQUAW SPIRIT, bumped at the start, made a mild bid between foes four wide into the upper stretch and failed to continue. GILDED BELLE, forwardly placed near the inside until the stretch, weakened thereafter. HER GREAT AFFAIR moved in three wide on the backstretch, was outsprinted, came out seven or eight wide for the stretch run and never menaced.
