**Footnotes**

RAPID RAJ, never far back and near the inside from the start, was lightly steadied leaving the half-mile ground, continued near the rail, took over entering the upper stretch, then was hard ridden to hold MONTSTAR safe. MONTSTAR gained the lead early, raced three or four wide, lost the advantage to the winner in the upper stretch, then held on stubbornly at the end. LUCKY PULPIT came out at the start lightly bumping NORTHERN STAG, was never far back while settling near the inside, was three wide into the final furlong and managed a mild gain. CHEROKEE PATH stalked the pace five wide into the final furlong and flattened out. SENOR AMIGO raced forwardly four wide into the stretch and faltered. NORTHERN STAG, lightly bumped at the start by LUCKY PULPIT, raced five or six wide and tired.
