QUITE READY disputed the pace along the inside, forged command leaving the turn, shook clear and held safely. BEPPONE hopped at the start, moved up three wide, kept on well but was unable to match strides with the winner. CAN'T PROVE IT was allowed to settle, angled out five wide leaving the turn and was just up to earn the show. DONE GONE attended the pace along the inside, got through entering the stretch but lacked the needed late response. COUSTEAU vied for the lead three wide through the turn and faltered. LE CHEVALIER failed to respond. BETTERLOOKOUT showed little.
